TOPlus chuck from HAINBUCH awarded Innovation Prize from Initiative Mittelstand

MARBACH. The TOPlus mineral-cast chuck has been making headlines ever since it was introduced to the market. The hexagonal chuck is impressive with 25% more holding power, central lubrication, improved dampening characteristics and a clamping head that is fitted jointlessly and solidly to the chuck surfaces and thus does not permit any radial displacement between clamping head and chuck body. Recently the trend-setting clamp concept has also been honored with an award: The 2007 Innovation Prize in the machine tool category.

Since 2006 this prize has been awarded by the Initiative Mittelstand to companies with the most innovative products for medium-sized businesses. »With TOPlus we hit a home run right from the start«, explains marketing director Sylvia Rail, »and I am not referring to just our customers alone. I am really pleased that we have been awarded the Innovation Prize. After all, more than 300 companies competed in 20 categories.
